VOLUNTEER SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made on _____ (date) by and between REDEEM CDC and

_____ (NAME), _____ (ADDRESS),
subsequently referred to as “volunteer”.

The volunteer intends to donate services to REDEEM and REDEEM intends to accept the donation of volunteer services and both parties in consideration of mutual promises, agree as follows:

Volunteer agrees to donate services as a **GARDEN** Volunteer. Such services shall include, but not be limited to, soil preparation including tilling the soil, adding soil fertilizer and other additives, weeding, planting and transplanting new plants, watering of the plants as required and harvesting produce.

Volunteer agrees to donate services as a volunteer at the Outreach Center as a **GENERAL VOLUNTEER**. Such services shall include, but not limited to serving clients by registering them for food and clothing distribution, preparing a package of food including prepared food and fresh produce, provide information about other community organizations (informal referrals).

1. It is mutually understood that your services as a volunteer are donated and that there is no monetary compensation in the present nor future for these voluntary services.
2. As a volunteer you agree to follow the supervision and direction of any personnel, or volunteer to whom you are assigned to perform volunteer services to REDEEM.
3. As a volunteer you understand and agree that you are responsible for injuries to third parties or damages to their property while acting outside the scope of assigned volunteer duties, and that you may be held personally liable for any monetary damages a court may award to the injured party.
4. As a volunteer you agree to notify REDEEM personnel immediately of any incident that occurs or may occur within your knowledge which gives rise to liability on your part.
5. You agree to recognize and assume all risks of accident and injury and understand that REDEEM CDC will not be held liable or legally responsible for any injury sustained by a volunteer, or for loss or damage to property owned or in your possession.
6. You and REDEEM will share responsibility for a safe working environment. You are expected to exercise caution while volunteering. Any accident which results in injury, regardless of how insignificant must be reported to a supervisor.
