We extend an invitation to you to participate in our composting program by bringing your kitchen scraps to the Outreach Center every Saturday.

(Kitchen caddy containers are available, upon request, for your collections.)

List of items to include for composting

- Fruit, vegetable scraps, and salad
- Coffee grounds/paper tea bags
- Bread/grains/cereals/rice/pasta
- Egg shells/banana and orange peels

- Nutshells
- Corncobs
- Stale beans/flour/spices
- Cut or dried flowers

Items not to include for composting

- Dairy products
- Meat/Fish bones/Pet refuse
- Fats/grease/oil/oily foods

- Cardboard (paper bags/plates/bowls)
- Plastic/metals/foil/glass/Styrofoam
- Diseased/insect-infested houseplants

FYI, compost is added to the soil to give nutrients when growing fruits and vegetables to improve the produce yield in the garden for our clients.
